- Board of Directors Election Meeting will be April 24th. Ballots will be mailed out March 22, 2021. Be sure to return the ballots by the deadline. It is very important that we make quorum.
- Boat registrations for the 2021 are underway. Requirements to register vessels are available on the association website, www.svla.com. All paperwork can be submitted on-line at Admin@svla.com. Once the safety inspection and measuring of the vessel is complete the registration process and payment can be completed at the admin office or on-line. Please call Public Safety to set-up the safety inspection. Part of the safety inspection is to verify the length of your boat. Maximum length for pontoon boats is 24 feet and all other boats is 22 feet.
- All Tenants must renew their membership. Tenant membership is November 1st to October 31st. You must renew every year. Applications are available on the website and in the association office.
- Sign-up for e-blasts; contact the association office to sign-up. All we need is your email address. A lot of information about the association can be found on our website, the association facebook page, the Breeze and bulletin boards through-out the community.
- The association is verifying and/or updating members contact information. This is to include phone numbers, email addresses, and emergency contacts. In case of an emergency, we want to be able to reach you by phone. Also, a lot of information is sent out by email. Email will get the info to you much faster than the Breeze newsletter which is once a month.
