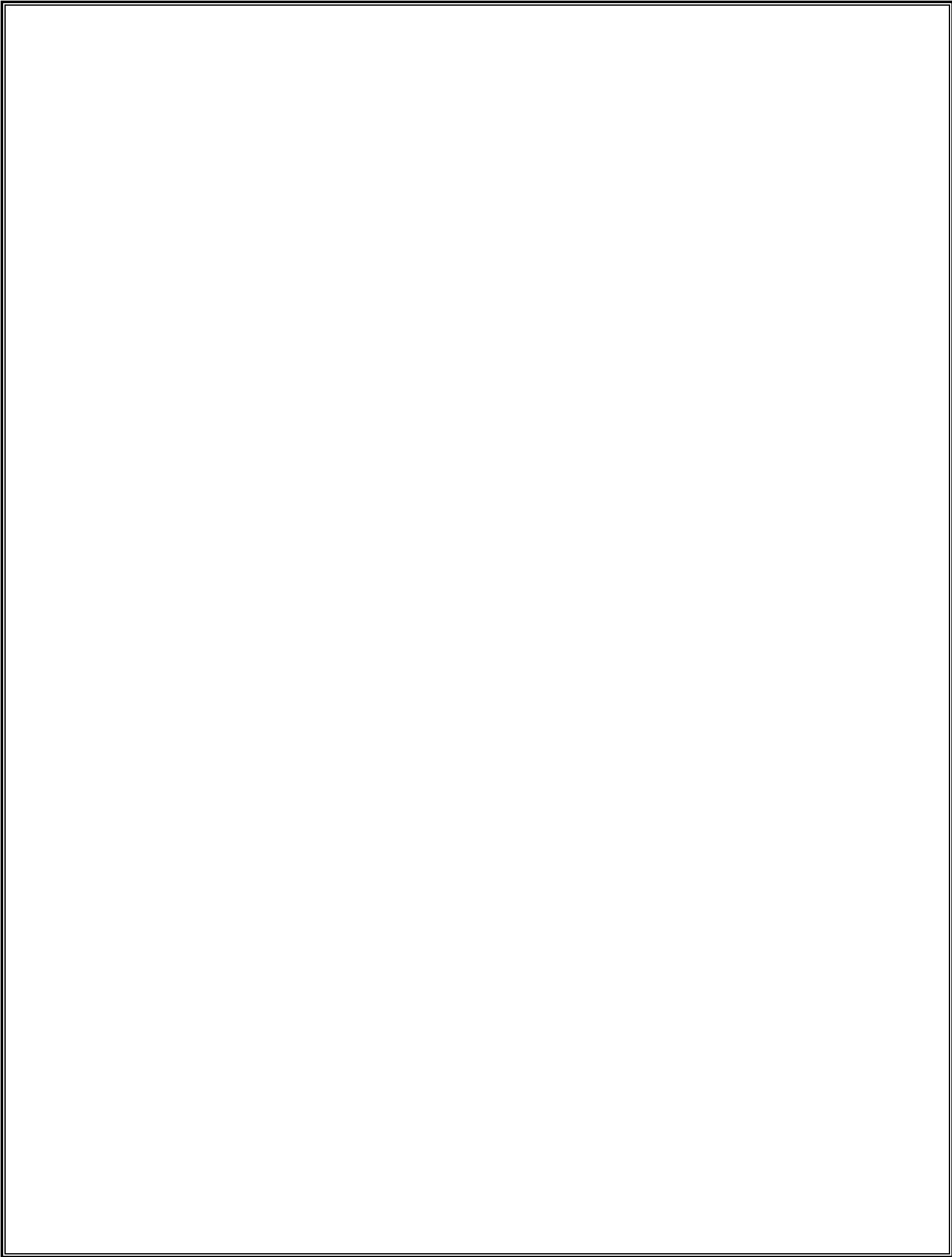
We encourage all those who have young boys to get them involved with the Cub Scouts or Boy Scouts to help shape them into outstanding men.
