This position is also tasked with managing the marina. The scope of work will include repairs on docks #1 though #111. The docks will be under maintenance for approximately 2 months. Some of the repairs that will be done are loose decking, loose bumpers, repair all broken and un-repairable dock/ slip siding, paint all metal upright railing poles etc., paint all wood, move all (low blue uprights) from Dock 4 (slips 88-111) with the (tall white uprights) from Dock 1(slips 1-32), remove all tires used as bumps from all SVLA slips, repair all deck edging, replace bumpers at fuel pump, and have boat covers made for #3 of the vessels.
