We hope you all are having a great start to 2023! Read on to see what has been going on in the Spring Valley Lake (SVL) community.

Coving Repairs Update

An Executive Board meeting took place on Thursday, January 5, 2023, 6:00 PM via ZOOM.

The Board of Directors have approved and will finalize contracts with Victorville Concrete for work on 17 lots, and LPC Inc. for work on Fishing Area #7 and 3 lots. The work should be completed approximately 45 days after approval. It will take approximately 90 days to fill our lake back to normal.



SVLA's maintenance team will be completing coving work on approximately 20 lots. Unforeseen weather may postpone the estimated completion date. The coving repair project will have an estimated total cost of \$746,000. We will send out more information as it becomes available.

We've received more rain than usual in the past couple of weeks. See the pictures of the rainbows below in case you missed it!








Event Committee
