It's March... feeling lucky yet? You will after reading our newsletter! See what's new with the Spring Valley Lake (SVL) community.



We are pleased to say that our coving repairs are completed, and we began filling the lake on March 3rd. It will take approximately 90 days to fill the lake to capacity.

We have contracted out the replacement of 2 slip sections.

Our contractor is 95% done with building the frames for the new slips. We are expecting to receive them by the end of March. Construction & assembly of the new slips in the water will take approx. 3-4 weeks.



The contractor will also move the returning slips back to the Marina. We expect this to take place towards the middle of April, being that the lake will need to be filled to a certain level. The two remaining slips will be inspected for repairs after they are reinstalled.

All slips are projected to be ready to use by the beginning of May!

Security Cameras: A Message from the Public Safety Department

All Spring Valley Lake residents are encouraged to have security systems installed to help deter break-ins and assist the Law Enforcement agencies when such incidents occur.

New or up-to-date cameras will provide better video

footage which is vital when a crime occurs. Getting a camera with night vision is imperative with security cameras. If they lack lights that enable color night vision, the security cameras should have infrared LED sensors to create a clear picture in the dark. Having at least one camera facing the driveway and street can help identify a vehicle's make and model, and which direction it fled. This will help the Spring Valley Lake Public Safety Department to use its cameras to pinpoint where the vehicle may have exited SVL and relay that information to Law Enforcement.

Please have outdoor lighting, particularly motion activated lighting. If a home burglary occurs, residents should call the Sheriff Department at 760-956-5001 and then the Public Safety Department at 760-245-6400.


