The Board Appointed Officers are:



Front of **Property:** Roof, House Numbers, Doors, Windows/Screens, Gates/Fences, Landscape, Trim, Stucco/Paint, Exterior Lighting, Garage Door, Driveway, **Unsightly Objects**

Rear of Property (Golf Course/Lakefront/EQ/River Walk): Roof, House Numbers, Railings, Gates/Fences, Deck/Dock, Unsightly Objects, Trim, Stucco/Paint/Exterior Lighting, Landscape, Pool

Work shifts/hours vary between 29-40 hours a week, Tuesday-Saturday.


