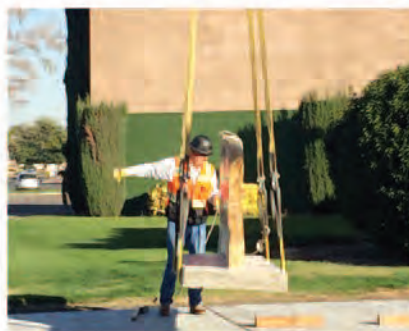

The holiday season is quickly approaching. Along with all the festivities and cheer that take place during these last few months of the year, there is also an increase in the number of residents who are buying gifts online and having them delivered to their homes. Unfortunately, this means that thieves now have ample opportunity to steal your packages that have been left out. To try and deter this behavior, it is essential to take precautionary steps to ensure your property is safe. If you have ordered a package and it is being delivered while you are away from home, try to contact the delivery company and request to pick it up at an authorized facility; or if possible have it delivered on a different date. If the delivery company cannot accommodate your request, try asking a neighbor, a friend, or a family member to pick up the package for you once it is delivered to your front door. If you have exhausted all other options, but you still need assistance call the Public Safety Department at (760-245-6400) and our staff can

provide, as an extra service, assistance by moving your package to a discrete location on your property. A Public Safety Officer will attempt to better conceal your package from the general view of the public; Or, as a last resort, the officer will bring the package to the Community Building where it can be picked up by the owner. Please keep in mind that this option is an absolute last resort, as the Public Safety Department does not have the room to hold your packages for more than 24 hours. It is also important to note that if the package size is too large for a Public Safety Officer to move safely, we will be unable to accommodate your request. If you are having us hold a package for you, know that you will be required to show your picture ID to retrieve it and it will only be released to the individual that the package is addressed to. This is a special courtesy that the Association is only providing during the holiday season; and we will not be responsible for any damages that might occur.

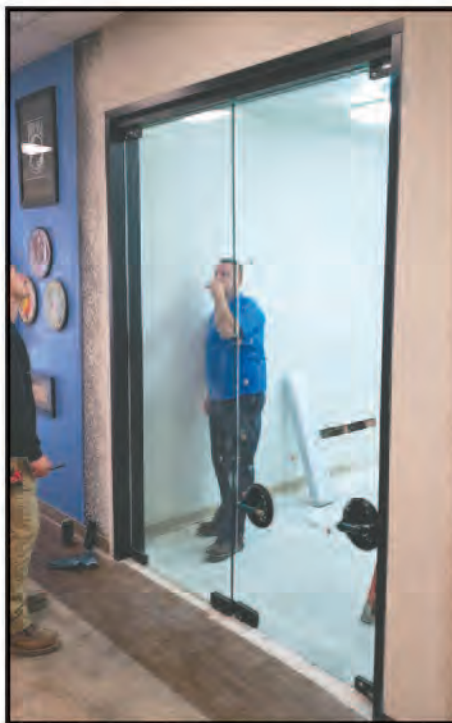
### Lake Side

We removed a large dead tree from Fishing area 13. We removed and replaced the dead plants at our fishing areas; seeded and fertilized for winter. These are all some of what has been completed around our community. We have also cleared all the v-ditches; removing dirt and debris

### MLP Project

Phase 1 of the Meadowlark Park project is complete. We are looking forward to starting Phase 2 of this park and get ready to open the full walking



path with exercise areas. These exercise areas will have outdoor exercise equipment installed in a future phase. Currently there is 1,760 linear feet of walking trail complete. Once we complete Phase 2 there will be .42 miles of walking trails in the park that will allow you to make a .64 mile loop. We are currently working on installing dog drinking fountains at the dog park. It will be completed this month. Placing additional public drinking fountains around the walking trails will be done in future phases. On the following page are a couple of master plan renderings.

# National Veterans and Military Families Month

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the end of WWI. This year, Veterans Affairs facilities in communities all across America take time to offer a special recognition of the significance of the U.S. participation in the 'war to end all wars'. We remember those who served our country in uniform on 11 November in the Great War – first as Armistice Day, and then, since 1954 as Veterans Day.



This year marks the 100th anniversary of the end of World War I. More than 16 million people fell on the battlefields in the world's first truly global conflict in human history, and most died young, anonymous, and under terrible conditions on foreign soil. In the "war to end all wars" more than four million American families sent their children to serve in the armed forces during World War I, including 116,516 lives lost in battle and due to illnesses, while 200,000 were injured, according to figures from the United States World War One Centennial Commission.

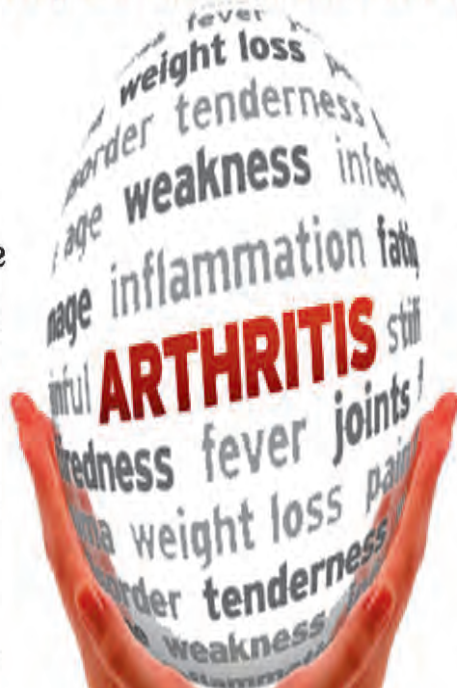
