Facilities, Maintenance and Grounds:

Weed abatement at EQ trails has been on-going this month.

Removed dead and/or diseased cypress trees around Meadowlark Park and removed the stumps.

All picnic tables and trash cans have been painted.

Installed 6 additional Dog waste stations (2-Meadowlark Park, 2-EQ, 1-FA4 and FA10).

Power washed the exteriors of the Community building and Association office.

Set new ADA compliant parking signs as required.

Lake and Fishing Areas:

Reset damaged or loose perimeter and centerline buoys.

Installed new bait cutting table at all fishing areas.

Dragged and weeded beach areas.

We have continued treatments of the swim area and also testing of our swim area water by Clinical laboratory of San Bernardino. June's results came back as follows:

Total Coliform 8MPN/100mL

Fecal Coliform 2MPN/100mL

The health department considers 200MPN/100mL and above unsafe.

Lake data has shown continued trend that our Alum treatments are providing a clearer lake water trend as show on the graph below. This treatment is one of the steps of our lake clarity plan to improve water quality.
