### **Facilities, Maintenance and Grounds:**

Installed additional surveillance cameras at the Association office.

Repaired wrought iron fence and gates at east and west beach.

Installed new Parkway flag holders at each light pole.

Painted picnic tables as needed at parks, east and west beaches.

Sprayed weeds at inner Bear Valley wall.

Continued landscaping and irrigation repairs at all areas.

Continued weed abatement at trails and required common areas.

Built a new dragger for the beach.

Weeded trails at EQ and parks.

We trimmed trees at east beach to remove unsafe limbs

### **Lake and Fishing Areas:**

Set 22 perimeter buoys and 13 centerline buoys.

Completed landscape improvements at FA 14. This will carry forward to FA 15, 1 and 2 were wells were replaced this year. This will then carry forward to each fishing area to match FA 14.

Carp control was done in 3 sweeps throughout this month as part of our lake clarity plan.

Installed new launch speaker phone and Quagga mussel information sign at the launch gate.

Cleaned and updated Marina gas pump with new face plates and stickers.

Dragged and weeded beach areas.

We have continued treatments of the swim area and also testing of our swim area water by Clinical laboratory of San Bernardino. May's results came back as follows:

Total Coliform     11MPN/100mL

Fecal Coliform     2MPN/100mL

The health department considers 200MPN/100mL and above unsafe.

Installed new Bait cutting tables at FA #2, 7, 8, 14 and 9

Maintenance is still compiling lake data on a weekly basis and I will graph this going forward on Ops reports starting in July
